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## What happens upon arrival

- Registration is by school, not individual.
- We ask that the faculty member register for all students; confirm attendees and turn in liability waivers.
- At registration, each school will receive a packet with nametags and information for each participant
- Light snacks served
- Use this time to get your bearings and locate your small group classroom
- Plan to be seated in large gathering space prior to 8AM

## What happens if someone is sick, or we need to swap attendees

- If possible, notify us ahead of time so we can prepare nametags update small group assignments
- If happens on day of, there will be a special check-in area to ensure the replacement has a nametag and is assigned to a small group.
- Please make sure the replacement brings a signed release form

## What happens if bad weather?

- February weather in the tri-state area does not always cooperate. In the 11 previous years, we have had 2 delayed starts, but no cancellations.
